## How to Host a Diaper **Drive at Work**

- 1. Choose an organization to donate your diapers
- 2. Alert your HR department and create awareness
  - · Find a convenient place for people to drop off diapers
  - · Label collection bins colorfully and clearly!
  - · Set goals for collection
- 3. Choose a date and time
  - · Pick a week or even a month
  - · Consider using a fun theme or timing your drive with a particular event
- 4. Enlist colleagues & online community
  - · Post flyers, send emails, share on social media
  - · Ask them to help promote and organize the drive
  - · Consider a friendly competition between departments or groups
  - · Send reminders at the beginning, middle, and end of the drive
- 5. Collect & tally
  - · Count donations and track on a spreadsheet
  - · Coordinate drop-off at benefiting organization
- 6. Recap and inspire others
  - · Publicize results throughout your company
  - · Send us (info@sweetcheeksdiaperministry.org) a recap that we can post to inspire others

## How to Host a Diaper Drive in Your Community

- 1. Let SCDM know your plans
  - · Choose a benefiting organization
  - · We can let you know about specific sizes needed
  - · We can help promote your drive
- 2. Choose a location
  - · Find a convenient place for people to drop off diapers
  - · Label collection bins colorfully and clearly!
  - · Set goals for collection
- 3. Choose a time
  - · Pick a week or even a month
  - Can you partner with a specific community event?
  - · Consider using a fun theme
- 4. Spread the word!
  - · Share a personal story
  - · Share on social media
  - · Send reminders and bi-weekly updates
- 5. Collect & tally
  - · Count donations and track on spreadsheet
  - · Coordinate drop-off at benefiting organization

## Host a diaper drive at: Motivate Donors

- · School
- · Church
- · Library/Coffee shop
- In lieu of gifts (for weddings, birthdays, showers)
- Virtual drive (using Amazon wish list, collect \$)

# Promote your drive with a flyer and a goodie bag

- Host a bake sale or collect loose change
- · Use the money to buy diapers
- · Ask people to shop in their own closets
- Maybe kids have outgrown their diaper size
- Host a "Bring your Left Over Gift Certificates Party"
- Ask friends to bring gift cards and use them to buy diapers
- Are you an artist or do you know someone who is?
- Consider auctioning photos or art and use money to buy diapers
- · Special events
- Get the event organizer to crosspromote your drive—attendees who bring diapers receive free or discounted entrance or raffle tickets

For Teachers: A diaper drive is a great opportunity for incorporating real-life lessons on poverty and working poor. It drives home concept that everything we do impacts people in our communities.

For Parents: Kids who host a diaper drive learn how to organize themselves and others, set goals, figure out logistics, how to negotiate rides, make pickups and deliveries and maybe even get local businesses to give discounts and donations.

For Companies: Your company can show how it's doing good in the community by matching donations or providing incentives to others for donating (free trial membership, gift cards, discount coupons).

## Tips & Tricks

- Personal acknowledgment for donations goes a long way!
- Teaming up with others allows for a larger network to spread the word
- Language such as "this time we collected/raised..." helps people understand there is an on-going need
- Pictures can express so much



#### Did you know?

- You can't buy diapers with food stamps or get them through WIC (Women, Infants and Children)
- 22% of all children under five years old in the U.S. live in poverty and 1 out of every 3 families struggle to afford diapers.
- If a family can't afford diapers, a baby may spend extended periods of time in the same soiled diaper.
- Diapers cost an average of \$75-\$100
   per month and that's a lot of dough to
   drop for the 46.2 million people living in
   poverty in the U.S.

## What this means:

The severe health and social consequences for babies and families who do not have access to diapers is a bum deal. Lack of enough diapers can lead to a whole mountain of problems for families in need: unhappy babies, unhealthy communities, under-educated toddlers, and under-employed adults. Something so basic as a diaper can actually have a big impact on a family's ability to become financially self-sufficient.
